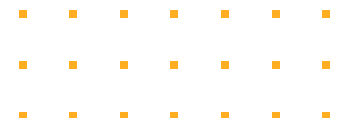

CMU is the first provincial university in Thailand, based on the government's policy and the objectives of the northern people, as a center for academic and occupational knowledge in order to benefit the region and the country as a whole.

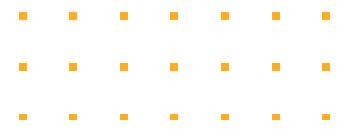

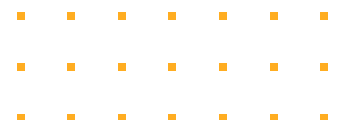
# Regulations and Rules



## Regulations

- Students must strictly follow the dormitory's rules and regulations.
- Students must keep the assets and the equipment of the dorm clean and in good condition.
- Inspection of appliances and materials in the room should be done before staying by students. In case of any damage during the stay, students will be charged for compensation.
- Those causing damage to such an asset must compensate for the failure in the amount as defined by the dormitory.
- Parking the motorbike and car in the provided area.
- Students must use the electricity and the water supply of the dorm economically, and must not go out with the electricity and the water supply turned on.
- Students must meet their visitors in the area as defined by the dorm. The permission can be obtained by the dormitory staff.
- When leaving the dormitory, students must move the luggage out of the room and drop off the room keys to dormitory staff; dormitory staff will check the room and the student will have to sign a key return form.

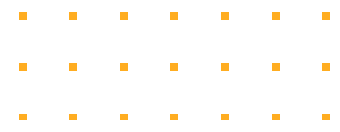
# Regulations and Rules



## Rules

- Not allowed to steal other persons' items.
- Gambling is not allowed in the dormitory
- Not allowed to consume illegal drugs, alcohol liquid, and any other intoxicants, or possess them in the residence.
- Not allowed to have a quarrel in and around the dorm.
- Not allowed to bring a weapon or a bomb and inflammable gas/fuel in and around the dorm.
- Not allowed to uninstall, modify, relocate or adjust the equipment of the dorm or do anything that causes damage to the dormitory properties.
- Not allowed to have sexual misbehavior in and around the dorm.
- Do not make loud noise or do any activities to disturb other people.
- Not to allow a non-resident or the opposite gender to enter the room without the dormitory or the authorized person's consent.
- Not allowed to bring electric equipment, which is not permitted by dormitory staff. The following appliances are prohibited in the dorm; washing machine, microwave, electric heater or gas stove, and any kind of cooking facilities.

# Regulations and Rules



## Rules

- Not allowed to cook in the room.
- Pets are not allowed in the dormitory room and around the building.
- Not allowed to host any parties or ceremonies without prior permission of the university dormitory.
- Not allowed to draw, stick-on wall pictures and put nails on the dormitory's dorm.
- Not allowed to do their own personal commercial activities without prior permission of the university dormitory.
- Not allowed to place objects such as shoe racks or shoes in front of the room.
- Not allowed to post a notice or an advertising leaflet in the dorm, except for in the area provided.
- Not allowed to smoke in the room.

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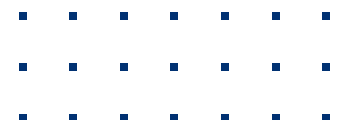
## Punishments

Students who violate the above rules and regulations will be punished as follows;

1. Verbal warning
2. Written warning
3. Nullification of dorm residency

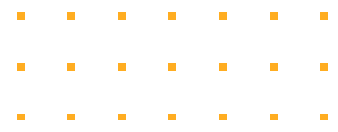
